## DESCRIPTION

Caminas is a naturally inspired solution against the irritation caused by external agents. It is a hypertonic saline 2,5% solution with Chamomilla Recutita at controlled pH useful for daily nasal hygiene. Caminas also helps to unblock and relieve nasal passages in case of cold.



2 - 3 sprays per nostril, 3 - 4 times a day, or more if needed

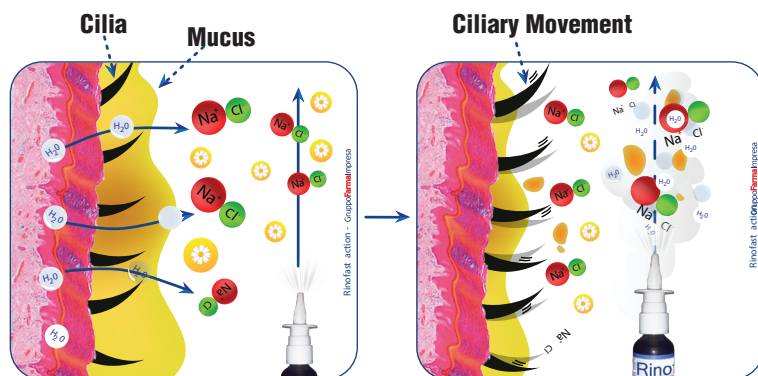

## OSMOTIC ACTION

*Immediate*

NaCl 2.5%, more tolerated than 3% NaCl-solution, creates an osmotic effect to gently draw and drain even thick mucus.



The first image shows the decongestant and fluidizing action of Caminas, thanks to the osmotic action of the hypertonic saline solution.

The second image shows the improvement of the functionality of the nasal mucosa, thanks to the increase of mucociliary clearance activated by the action of hypertonic solution.



*A preservative-free and sterile alternative to standard nasal sprays*

- Constant volume for each spray.
- Moreover, the conical jet is more delicate and permits the utilization even when the nasal mucosa is more sensitive (in case of irritation)
